

- Vacuuming will help dislodge dirt particles and will keep the pile from matting.
- If the fabric is outdoors, it can be thoroughly hosed down. As with any surface, please use caution when wet. Do not walk on the fabric until it is completely dry.
- Spot-clean the fabric as soon as you notice spills. Use paper towels or an absorbent cloth to blot liquids and scoop up solids immediately. Use a gentle stain cleaner to lift the stain (always pre-test spot cleaner in an inconspicuous area first, to make sure it is safe for use on the fabric). Do not saturate the fabric when spot cleaning. Always apply cleaner to the cleaning cloth and not directly to the fabric, and blot the stain instead of rubbing. Rubbing may spread the stain or distort the pile. Do not use silicone-based stain repellents on the fabric, as they tend to accelerate soiling.
- Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life and looks of the fabric for years to come.
- As an added benefit, fibers are naturally mold and mildew resistant.
