

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

BEDDING: Including 100% Polyester Prints and Piece-dyes and woven fabrics for Top of Bed, Bedding Accessories, Shower Curtains, and Bed Throws

WASHING INSTRUCTION FOR ALL BEDDING PRODUCTS:

- Machine wash, warm. 120 to 140 degrees Fahrenheit
- Use only non-chlorine bleach if needed.
- Wash with like colors and products
- Do not overload washer.
- Do not use any fabric softeners
- Do not use any abrasive chemicals (i.e. Scour) in the rinse cycle.
- Tumble dry low temperature setting.
- Do not overload dryer, remove items promptly to prevent excessive wrinkling.
- Inspect dryer drum for burrs. File burrs down to prevent snags
- Use iron at low setting when needed

DRAPERY/SHEERS: 100% Polyester Prints, Piece-dyes and Yarn Dyed Wovens

DRY CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL DRAPERY PRODUCTS:

- We recommend that all Drapery Products be professionally dry-cleaned by a licensed Dry Cleaning professional.
- We suggest a routine of weekly care such as lightly dusting or hand-vacuuming at low suction.
- The use of a hand-wanded steam presser can be used to remove wrinkles.
- Please take extra care not to catch or snag the fabric (especially sheers), when dusting, and especially if low suction vacuuming is used.

SPOT CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL DRAPERY PRODUCTS:

- We suggest contacting a reputable cleaning service or cleaning supply house for a spot cleaning product that is suitable for your specific fabric. Any stain removal products should be used with a handy spray bottles, and a clean dry white cloth. The Cleaning Instructions on the label should be followed carefully. Always test a small inconspicuous area first to prevent damage or discoloration to the fabric. PKC bears no responsibility for the cleaning product performance or results.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL DRAPERY PRODUCTS:

- Machine wash, warm. 120 to 140 degrees Fahrenheit
- Use non-chlorine bleach if needed
- Wash with like colors and products
- Do not overload machine
- Do not use any fabric softeners
- Do not use any abrasive chemical (i.e. Scour from Ecolab) in the rinse cycle
- Tumble dry, medium
- Do not overload washer
- Do not overload dryer, remove promptly

- Inspect dryer drum for burrs. File burrs down to prevent snags
- Use iron at low setting when needed

- The washing instructions above are suitable for piece goods. PKC recommends all finished drapery products to be cleaned by a professional cleaning service. PKC is not responsible for any damage to hooks or hardware, or to the integrity of the Drapery pleat or shape. Please refer to Dry Cleaning and Spot Cleaning instructions below as needed.

UPHOLSTERY: Woven Yarn-dyed or Piece-dyed fabrics

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL UPHOLSTERY PRODUCTS:

- Vacuum or dust furniture regularly to prevent permanent soiling
- Professional Dry Cleaning is recommended on an annual basis, or as needed.
- Seat cushions and back pillows should be rotated and turned on a regular basis. This will minimize premature wear, control seam slippage, and help to maintain an even fabric color.
- Cushion covers and pillows should not be removed for separate dry cleaning or washing.
- If Spot Cleaning is necessary, clean with mild water free cleaning solvents. Do not oversaturate as this can damage the interior foam. Do not use water. Spot cleaning can cause a ring or some fading. Always pre-test a small, inconspicuous area first.
- When Spot Cleaning, blot stain immediately using a clean white dry cloth. Do not rub or scrub the spill into the fabric. Clean spots or stains from the outside toward the middle.
- Pile fabrics may require brushing and steaming with a non-metallic bristle brush to restore appearance.

POLYURETHANE OR POLYPROPYLENE: fabrics for upholstery use

WEEKLY MAINTENANCE:

Protect from direct sunlight. Routinely wipe clean with a damp sponge and/or vacuum with a soft brush attachment to remove airborne particles. Do not iron. Keep a safe distance from any heat.

CLEANING:

Blot liquid spills with a clean dry cloth. Wipe with a clean cloth dampened with a mild detergent solution. Do not use abrasive powders or past solutions. Do not wet excessively. A soft bristle brush may be used to remove ingrained soil. Avoid any rough scratching of the surface by brushing gently. Wipe dry with a clean dampened cloth to remove any excess detergent. Air-dry away from any direct heat. Do not machine clean or use hot water extraction. Do not iron.

SPOT CLEANING:

Persistent marks may require solvents. You may apply a solvent spray product like Formula 409 or Fantastik with a soft dampened cloth. Wipe area down with plain water and dry with a clean lint-free cloth. Always pre-test in a small, inconspicuous area first, to prevent any damage to the fabric.

FINISHED PRODUCTS: 100% Polyester with the exception of Bedskirts:

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BEDDING PRODUCTS:

- Machine wash, warm. 120 to 140 degrees Fahrenheit
- Use only non-chlorine bleach if needed
- Wash with like colors and products
- Do not overload washer
- Do not use any fabric softeners
- Do not use any abrasive chemical (i.e. Scour) in the rinse cycle
- Tumble dry low temperature setting
- Do not overload dryer, remove items promptly to prevent excessive wrinkling
- Inspect dryer drum for burrs. File burrs down to prevent snags
- Use iron at low setting when needed

BEDSKIRTS: 100% Polyester BEDSKIRTS

DRY CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BEDSKIRT PRODUCTS:

- We recommend that all Bedskirts be professionally dry-cleaned by a licensed Dry Cleaning professional. Washing can cause excessive shrinkage, or damage to the pleating. This may cause an improper fit, or a change in appearance.
