V-69 Polyester vs. V-92 Polyester

V-69



Has a breaking strength of 10.6 pounds



For use on decorative outdoor fabrics and marine fabrics for home machines



Can be use on home or industrial sewing machines

V-92



About 30% stronger than V-69 Thread



For use with heavy canvas, marine fabrics, or sails



Recommended for use on industrial sewing machines and all Sailrite Machines

Both V-69 and V-92

- Typically last up to 10 years outdoors in mild climates and 2-3 years in a harsh environment*
- Resistant to heat, abrasion, mildew and salt water
- High stability in sunlight and UV resistant
- High strength and stretch control
- Rarely frays
- The black and white threads are solution dyed meaning the color runs all the way through the thread making the color more UV resistant. Other colors may fade from exposure to the sun.
